Parents and Players responsibilities

1. It is the player's or parent/guardian's responsibility to ensure the player is at the correct venue by checking with the Team Manager/Coach.

3. It is player's or Parent/guardian's responsibility to inform the Team Manager/Coach if a player is unavailable for training sessions or games.

In the case of a child player, all parents / guardians will assist (on rotation) the club / team by manning the canteen, line marking, erection of nets, oranges, drink bottles and laundering of uniforms, - a roster will be issued to all parents by the Team Manager before the season commences. If you cannot take your turn it is your responsibility to make alternative arrangements and to inform the Team Manager of roster changes.
5. Being the applicant or parent of the abovenamed applicant/s, I/we agree that the activity organized or conducted by RCSC is in the nature of sport and as such has some dangers and risks.
